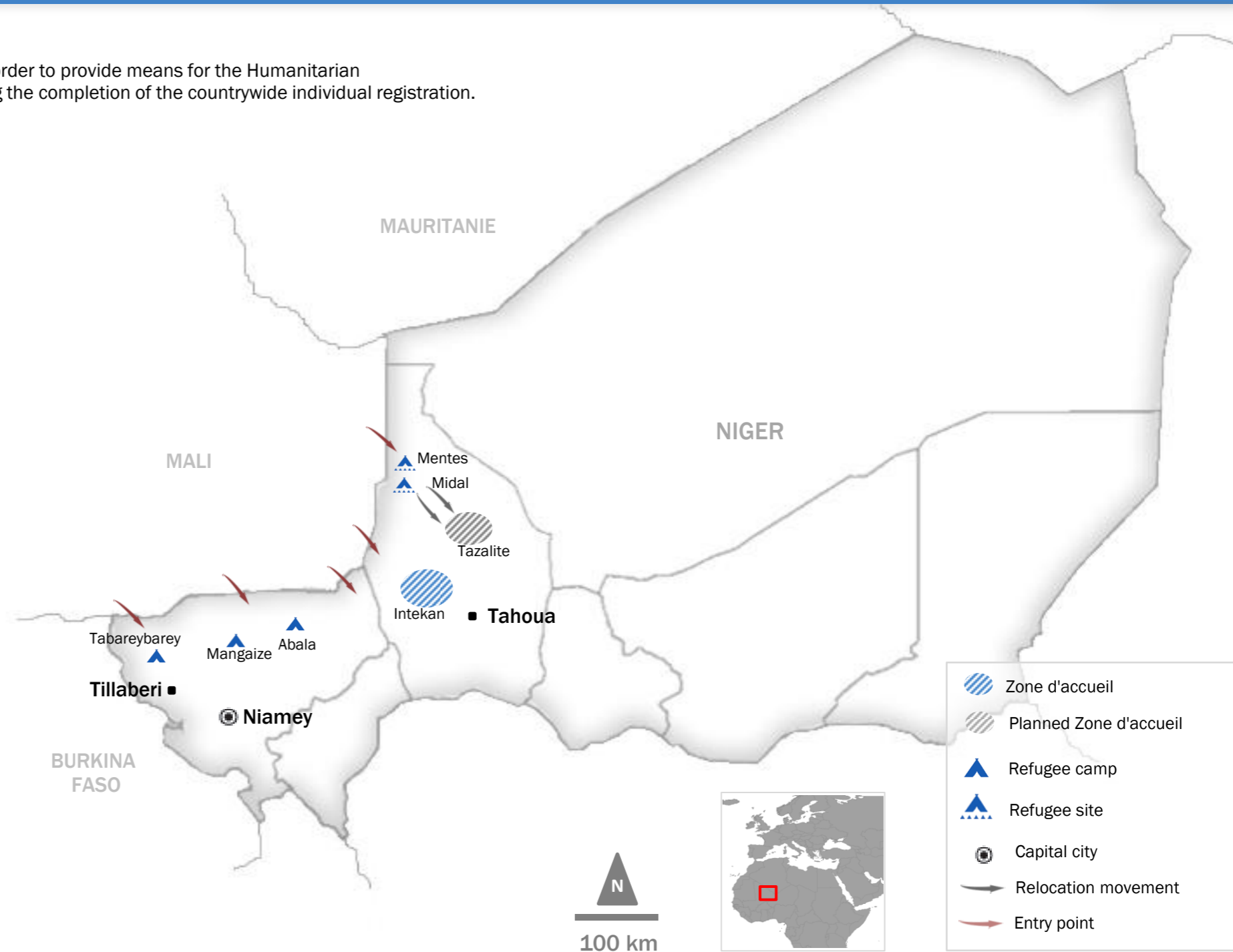

UNHCR Niger's 5 core projects and innovations

DOMESTIC ENERGY

Identify a source of energy, other than firewood and charcoal to be made available to the refugees who are known to sell parts of their food rations in order to purchase firewood for cooking purposes in a desert area where trees and firewood are scarce.

ZONE D'ACCUEIL

Keeping nomadic refugees' lifestyle by offering them a free spacious area to roam around with their herds rather than containing them in a camp.

ONE STOP SHOP / GUICHET UNIQUE

UNHCR and all partners will work from the same location to provide to urban refugees all services and activities relevant to them.

COUPON-BASED FOOD DISTRIBUTION

Improve refugees' dignity by offering them the choice of the type, of the timing and the place of receipt of food assistance.

FILETS SOCIAUX / SAFETY NETS

Ensure reintegration into their areas of origin for 3,127 returnees (Niger National) currently living in refugee camps.
