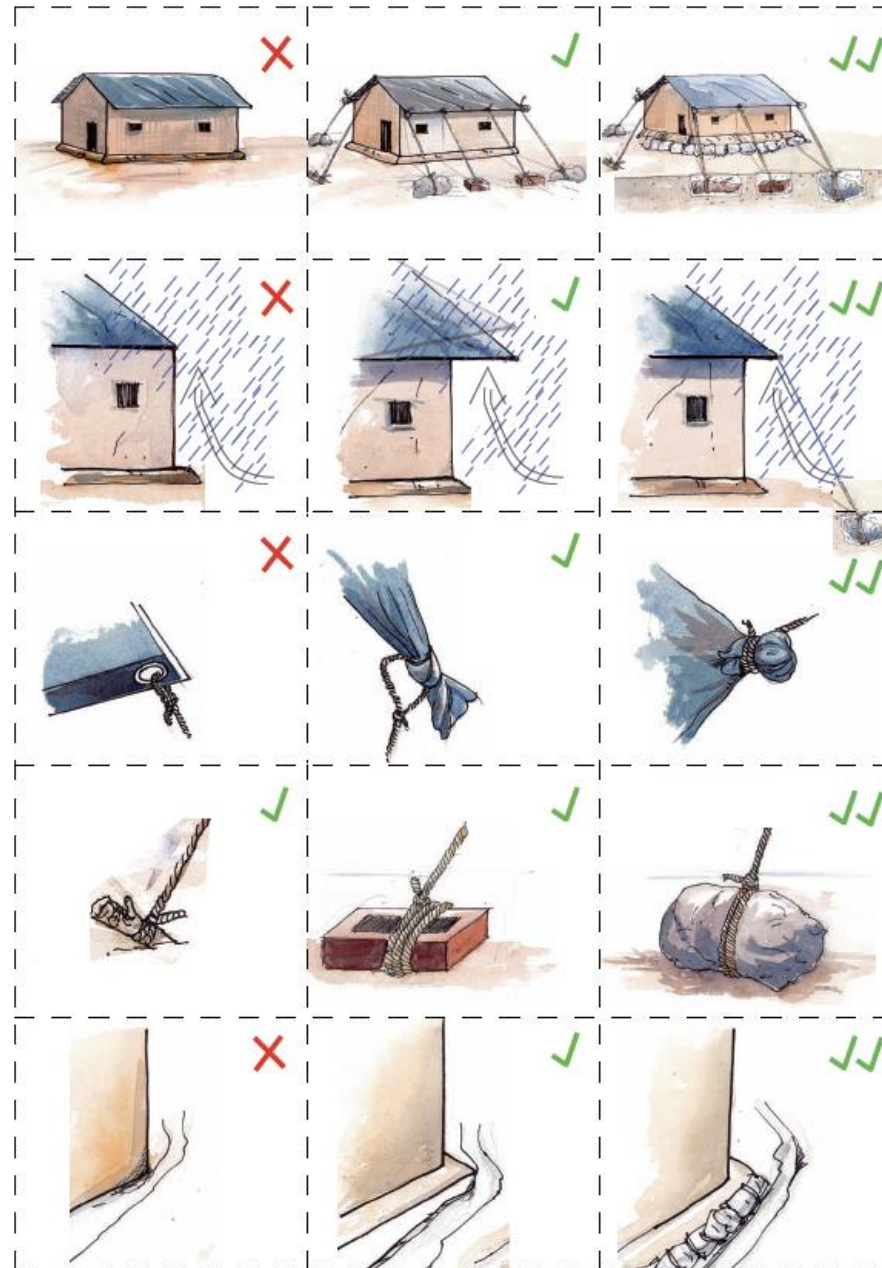
# **Last-minute preparedness: Shelter component**

- Analysis of typical damage caused by common predictable disasters
- Agreement of SOPs with local stakeholders and representative communities
- Preparation of locally adapted, standard last-minute interventions (Key items? Kits? Cash?)
- Last-minute IEC materials (What is useful? What is memorable?)
- **Shelter guidelines, as part of larger multi-sectoral package – due out soon!**
