WHAT IS GREEN RESPONSE?

- Initiative of Swedish Red Cross, supported by Australian RC and Canadian RC
- One of the workstreams of IFRC's multi-year priority of "Operational Excellence"
- Scope is beyond shelter and settlements. It will look at all relevant sectors or areas of humanitarian response
 - Logistics, WASH 2016
 - Shelter and settlements 2017-18









PURPOSE OF GREEN RESPONSE INITIATIVE

- Primary purpose of Green Response remains saving lives, alleviating suffering and maintaining/restoring human dignity.
- Responsibility to avoid or at least reduce potential harm –
 including limiting possible negative impacts on the physical
 environment and ecosystems as much as practically possible.
- Not about saving the environment, but reducing adverse impact generated through the response.











Communities and society depend on environment and ecosystems. Harming these assets that underpin the foundation to longer-term well-being and development should be limited.









GREEN RESPONSE FOR SHELTER AND SETTLEMENTS

- Methodology: Desktop review, key informant survey, key informant interviews, focus group workshop
- Identify benefits, barriers, current level of considerations, key issues, recommendations
- Map available resources, tools, trainings, initiatives, networks
- Develop internal RC Green Response Action Plan and Best Practice Recommendations for shelter and settlements programming
- Explore potential options for wider dissemination/ collaboration
