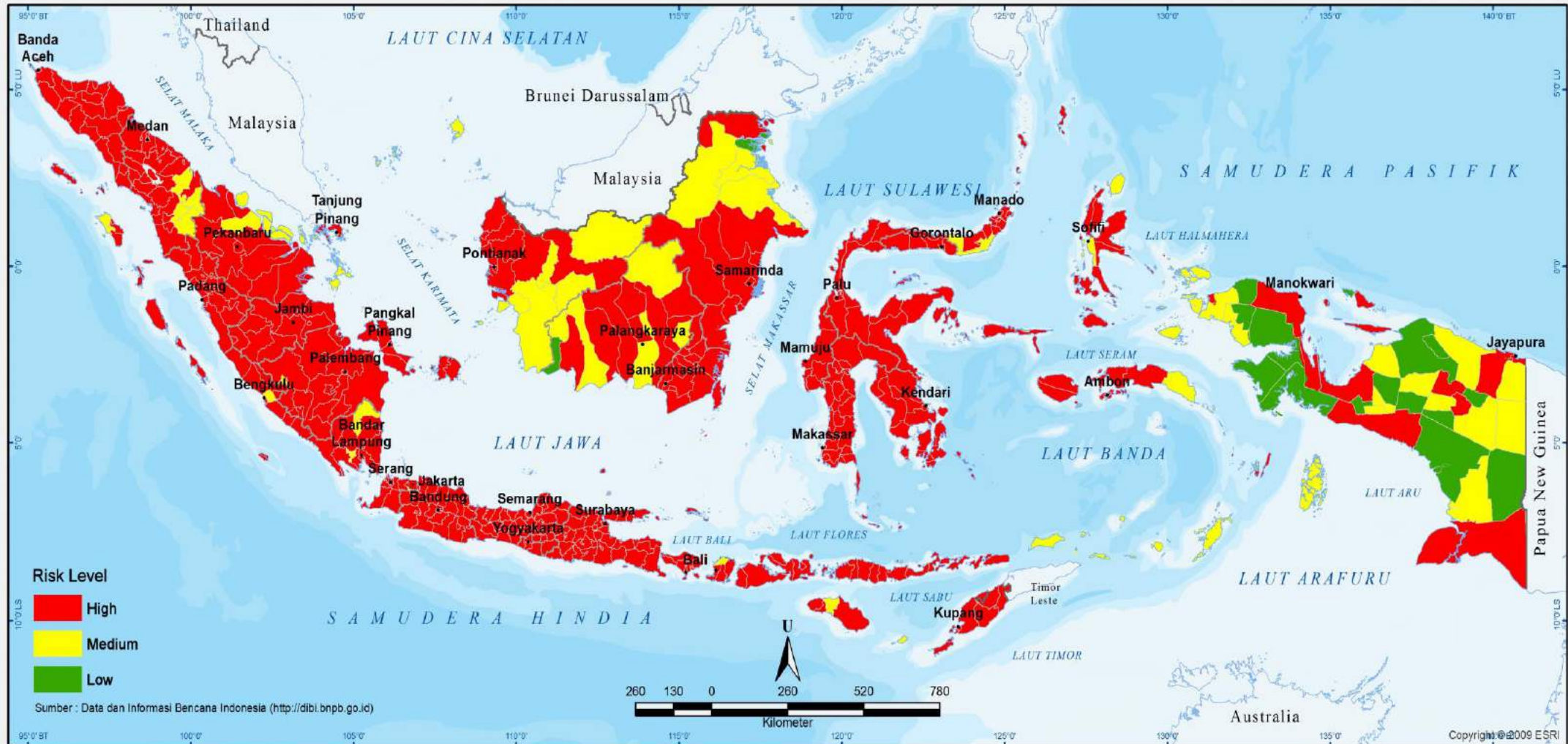

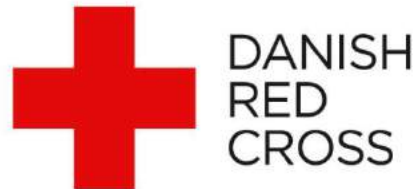
DISASTER RISK INDEX MAP OF INDONESIA 2012

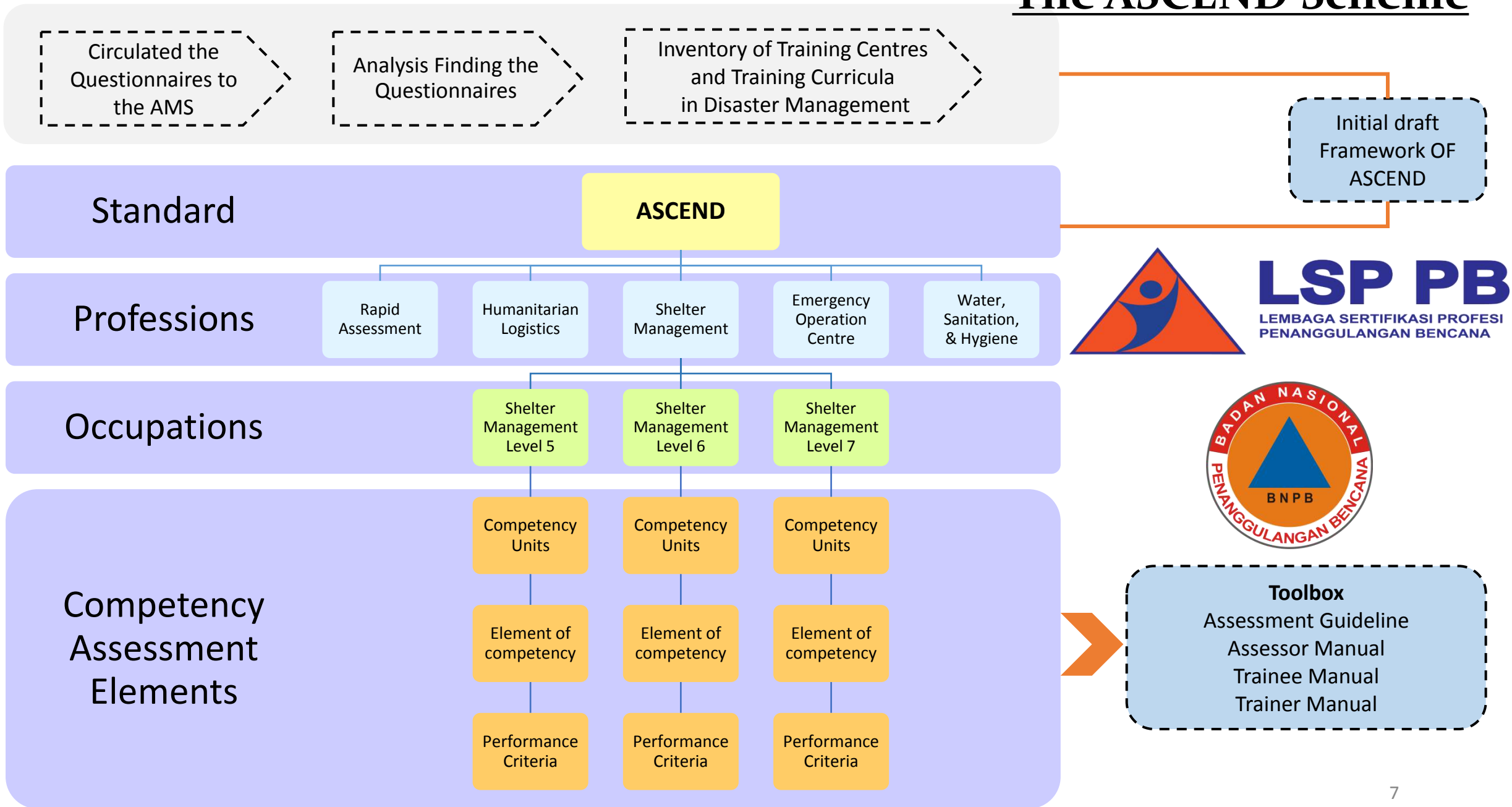
