
Library content can be **exported** and **downloaded** at any time by anyone

The common library will have:

- vacancies;
- events;
- on-line members forum;
- regional listening devices;
- regional cluster announcement page; and
- partners contribute resources to the library.

Why is this different?

• It's **open source** and everyone can upload and participate;

- it will be **open to anyone**;
- it will have **easy to use features** popular amongst commercial sites;
- we already have '**buy in'** from agencies willing to collaborate; and
- it will be **constantly updated** with relevant information.

The library will:

- make individual upload possible;
- improve the **transfer of information**
- create a **collective memory**;
- increase engagement
- foster communities of practice;
- preserve more **local information**;
- improve access to technical resources.

This will result in:

- improved technical capacity;
- agencies responding quicker and more appropriately; and
- beneficiaries receiving faster and more adequate assistance.
