Shelter Meeting in Geneva, 5 November 2004



### Background:

- Sierra Leone, 2002: Humanitarian workers reacted to poor quality of protection and assistance in camps, poor management of camps
- Inter-Agency Working Group in Sierra Leone
  - Aims: Map Camp Management responsibilities, review lessons learned, identify good practice





- Members: OCHA, IRC, NRC, UNHCR & Sierra Leone Government representative (NACSA). Close dialogue with residents in Jembe camp
- Funding from the Norwegian MFA
- NRC was chosen as Project Focal Point
- Developed first draft of Toolkit, which was field tested in Liberia, Sierra Leone and Angola




#### Camp Management Toolkit Editorial Group

# The Camp Management Toolkit



- Basic information on most aspects of camp operations.
- Complements existing sectoral guidelines, standards



- Defines roles, responsibilities of Camp Management Team
- Target group include camp management teams, sector/specialised agencies, camp residents, local authorities, etc.
- Includes tools and lists of essential reading
- A "living document" Field testing & feedback welcome!




## Camp Management Project 2004-05

   of ToTs and workshops




- Advocacy through presentations, list serves, websites, articles, etc.
